Project visit to Lebanon on behalf of Finnish Psychologists for Social Responsibility (FAFS) and Finnish-Arab Friendship Society (FAFS) 13 -24 February 2018. Report compiled on 3 October 2018 in Helsinki, Finland by Sirkku Kivistö

The main purpose of the visit was to compile the reports of the previous year and to plan the follow-up projects. It was, again, a fruitful project visit. Thank you all in Beit Atfal Assumoud!

The main outputs

Preparation of the project reports for 2017 of FiPSR and FAFS to the Ministry with coordinators Liliane Younes, Fatima Khaizaran and administration officer Diab Kassem. The reports were delivered to the Ministry in April 2018 (FiPSR already received information about their acceptance on 24 September 2018). We decided to switch from biannual financial reporting to reporting every three months to be able to monitor the costs more carefully and to get approval for potential budget changes, which is obligatory if the changes are bigger than 15% from the accepted budget item. During our meetings, we saw the drafts of MSN and Family Happiness progress report reviews 2017.

Evaluation of the project period 2017-2018: could we do it in cooperation with NORWAC? Usually evaluation is based on feedback from parents and FGC staff. Now we wish to carry out a new trial. Would it be possible collect children's own feedback? At least one sample in some FGC in a limited time period?

Preparation of FiPSR and FAFS follow-up project plans for 2019-2022. We decided on the long-term and immediate objectives of the projects, signed with Director Kassem Aina the preliminary partnership agreement and got cost estimates for the project plan from the financial department. The applications were delivered to the Ministry on 13 May 2018 under the title "Mental health for vulnerable groups: A complex multidisciplinary model containing client centered and community approaches". FAFS support €212,500 to the northern FGCs and FiPSR support €255,000 to the southern FGCs. The Ministry will inform about its decision in December 2018. The self-financing share (15% of the total project budget) consists of sponsorship money collection and financial value of the voluntary work. The projects, if accepted, will enable mental health services. Also, strong emphasis is placed on the development of a revised strategic plan after more than 20 years of practice of the mental health program.

Interview of FGC social workers Dalal Shahrour and Hala El Sayed, published in FAFS newspaper 1/2018, 3 May 2018

We checked the list of sponsored children, KG children and elderly (FAFS) and the list of children with multiple special needs (FiPSR) with coordinators Fatima Khaizaran (FAFS sponsorships), and Liliane Younes (FiPSR MSN sponsorships). During the visit, I met one sponsored child, one sponsored elderly (Family Happiness), and eight sponsored children with multiple special needs and reported their news to the sponsors in Finland.

Agreement on a group visit in September, combining the program partly to the Sabra & Shatila commemoration week. Implementation: 12 persons in Lebanon 15-22 September 2018

Mental health program strategic plan, discussions with director Kassem Aina and FGC Beirut team. Planning is on the agenda and progressing slowly. It is also linked to the Mental Mealth and Substance Use Strategy for Lebanon 2015-2020. BAS prepares a Memorandum of Cooperation with the Ministry of Public Health MOPH. The vision is for all people living in Lebanon to have the opportunity to enjoy the best possible mental health and wellbeing.

Following the efforts of the mental health program through several meetings: participation in steering committee for the 12th mental health conference. Participation in the conference 'Mental health and social security: Between clinical and civil activism' by ABAAD and Taybeen. Participation in team meeting of FGC Nahr el-Bared. Meeting with Dr Jihane Rohayem and Ibtissam Khalil in FGC Saida.

Some delightful information and observations

- * "We have a better structure than before for awareness sessions", social worker Dalal Shahrour, FGC Beddawi
- * The Mental Health and Social Security conference created discussions in the FGCs about more actively sharing with other NGOs specialized in some problem area, e.g. Union Pour la Protection de l'Enfant (UPEL), Himaya, Abaad etc. E.g. assisting schools to prevent violence at schools needs joint efforts in Nahr el-Bared (FGC team in Nahr el-Bared)
- * Mr Raghid Al Adass was asked how he monitors the corruption issue and cleanliness of the NGOs as part of the audit process. The description confirmed the trust in that BAS is clean, even though it operates in a country with a severe corruption problem (Lebanon 2017 ranking 143/180 by score 28/100 by Transparency International)
- * Dr Madeleine Badaro Taha has prepared an information sheet for the financial department in which she notes down all interventions and accepted costs of each MSN child. This makes it possible to follow the costs of tuition fees, medical assistance and in some cases, support for transportation.
- * Monitoring the living conditions of the sponsored families and elderly people, included in the social work, was performed by visiting the home of one elderly person in Bourj el-Barajneh. The couple is suffering from asthma and living in severely humidity damaged apartment. The social worker will make a proposal to UNRWA's shelter rehabilitation program (made, information during September 2018 visit).
- * Based on 20 years' experience, the administration of BAS is reflecting on what kind of skills the leadership of the mental health program and/of the Family Guidance Centers will need for a successful future development.
